

Drawing on years of experience as performers and producers, composer/lyricist **Michael Ching** and director **Dean Anthony** have created a one act opera that is perfect for apprentice programs, college and university opera workshops, fundraising events, and second stage productions.

Speed Dating Tonight imagines a speed dating session at a bar in contemporary America. With traditional opening and closing numbers, the middle section of the opera is a group of one-to-two-minute "dater arias" which can be put together according to the number of singers available. The order, key, and, in many cases even the gender, of the daters is flexible. There are varied types. Titles include:

Some are moving, some are funny. Some are caricatures, some are sincere. There are twenty-five dater arias and duets from which every producer will choose the ones they want to include.

Set in a bar, **SPEED DATING TONIGHT!** has minimal scenic and costume requirements. Running time, depending on the number of dates used, is 50-75+ minutes. Accompaniment is piano with some a cappella singing. There is also an orchestration: clarinet (fl)/drum set (vibraphone)/piano/bass

The piano vocal score to **SPEED DATING TONIGHT!** Comes as a printable pdf file that is meant to be reordered according to the desire of the producer. No two productions are the same. Producers fill out a checklist and the piano vocal score is tailored according to the cast you have available—one person's dater #2 will be a soprano, at another company it will be a bass.

Cast: Bartender Baritone Waitress Mezzo

Dating Coordinator Mezzo or Soprano Daters 8-20 varied voices

The musical style of the opera is a tonal mix of opera and music theatre.

Origamist

I'm Carey/Carrie. I'm kind of shy. I'm kind of shy. I work a lot. Don't get up much. Don't get OUT much! Up... out... You know what I mean. I don't talk much either. I can go for days without talking, seems like... There's nothing wrong with me or anything. Non-smoker! I don't snore! Or at least I don't think so. Non-smoker. Non-snorer. That's pretty good right? Do you snore? I don't think I could live with a snorer! Snorer. Is that a word? I think I'm snoring you. BORING you! I'm an origami designer. (Hands over a beautiful origami.) My card's in there. You can look me up. Please look me up.

Pat the Bassoonist

I play the bassoon in the symphony. Do you know what a bassoon is? That's it! The tall one that Looks like a tube. I'd like to date someone who's not in music. But that can be tricky. I play in concerts ev'ry weekend with the symphony. It can interfere with dating. Maybe you'd like to come to a concert? Then we could go out afterwards. You don't have to like classical music. But you have to like beer! Do you like beer? Then let's get together. I'm Pat Number seven. Pat the bassoonist. Number seven.

Regular

I've always liked this bar. It's such a friendly place. It's a nice mix of regulars and strangers. There's a TV in the corner to catch up on all the scores, And some private little tables if who your with matters more. Some friends of mine met here, And they're married now. So I think: "try this out and you might get lucky!" So tell me your story, then I'll tell you mine. And let me order you another glass of wine.
