Flight Schedule:

1. Fly personnel from Las Vegas (KLAS) to Indian Springs Aux AFB (KINS) and Desert Rock (DRA) returning to Las Vegas - 110nm.
2. Fly personnel from Las Vegas to Yucca Airstrip (NV11) and Pahute Mesa (L23) returning to Las Vegas - 166nm.
3. Fly equipment from Air Force Plant 42, Palmdale (KPMD) to Tonopah Range (TNX). Return to Palmdale (KPMD) - 400nm.
4. Fly personnel from Palmdale (KPMD) to NAWS China Lake (KNID) and return to Palmdale (KPMD) - 133nm.
5. Fly personnel from Edwards AFB (KEDW) to Point Mugu NAS (KNTD) - 78nm.
6. Fly equipment from Pt Mugu (KNTD) to Alamogordo-White Sands (KALM) - 662nm.
