



VF-13 Operation Deny Flight – Bosnia-Herzegovina

As a result of the continued conflict in the former Yugoslav Republic of Bosnia-Herzegovina UN Security Resolution 816, created a “No Fly” Zone in Bosnian airspace. Operation Deny Flight was intended to stop offensive operations by the Serbian Air Force against civilians. All flights were banned except humanitarian supply and military support flights. Maritime patrols were also introduced to prevent arms reaching the Serbs.

Bombing Attacks – F-16, Tornado
Maritime Patrol – E-3 Sentry, P-3 Orion
No Fly Patrol – E-3 Sentry, EA-6 Prowler, KC-135
Humanitarian Supply – C-5, C-17, C-130

1. Fly from Pescara (LIBP) to Sarajevo (LQSA) – 201 NM.
2. Fly from Bari (LIBD) to Mostar (LQMO) – 138 NM.

Bombing Attacks

Total flight distance 2,657 NM.
All routes and altitudes at pilot’s discretion.
Caution. Serbian SAM sites operational at many locations.
