Martin B26 Marauder

### Mission Legs

1. Low level coastal patrol. From Cairo West, HECW. Overfly: Borg El Arab, HEBA. Mersa Matruh, HEMM. Sidi Barrani, HE1D. (FSX HE40) AS Sallum, HE0T. (FSX HE19) Mersa Matruh, HEMM. Return to Cairo West. 614 nm.

2. Bombing Attack. From Cairo West, HECW. Simulated low level bombing of Axis armour at Misheifa, HE1E. (FSX HE41) Return to Cairo West. 534 nm.
3. Mine Laying. From Al Ishmailiyah, H000. Simulate low level mine laying in Benina Benghazi Harbour, HLLB. Land and refuel at Mersa Matruh, HEMM. Return to Al Ishmailiyah. 1240 nm.
4. Anti-Axis shipping patrol. Surveillance of Axis supply ships -Italy to Libya. Patrol route from Mersa Matruh, HEMM to Luqa LMML. Land ,refuel and return to Cairo West. HECW. 1585 nm.
