Mission Legs

- 1. Low level coastal patrol. From Cairo West, HECW.Overfly: Borg El Arab, HEBA. Mersa Matruh, HEMM. Sidi Barrani, HE1D. (FSX HE40) AS Sallum, HE0T. (FSX HE19) Mersa Matruh, HEMM. Return to Cairo West. 614 nm. FS2004 Flightplan FSX Flightplan X-Plane Flightplan
- 2. Bombing Attack. From Cairo West, HECW. Simulated low level bombing of Axis armour at Misheifa, HE1E. (FSX HE41) Return to Cairo West. 534 nm.
- 3. Mine Laying. From Al Ishmailiyah, H000. Simulate low level mine laying in Benina Benghazi Harbour, HLLB. Land and refuel at Mersa Matruh, HEMM. Return to Al Ishmailiyah. 1240 nm.
- 4. Anti-Axis shipping patrol. Surveillamce of Axis supply ships -Italy to Libya. Patrol route from Mersa Matruh, HEMM to Luqa LMML. Land ,refuel and return to Cairo West. HECW. 1585 nm.

Total mission distance 3973 nm. 4 flights required for ribbon credit. Combat range of B26 1000 nm.
